August Intro

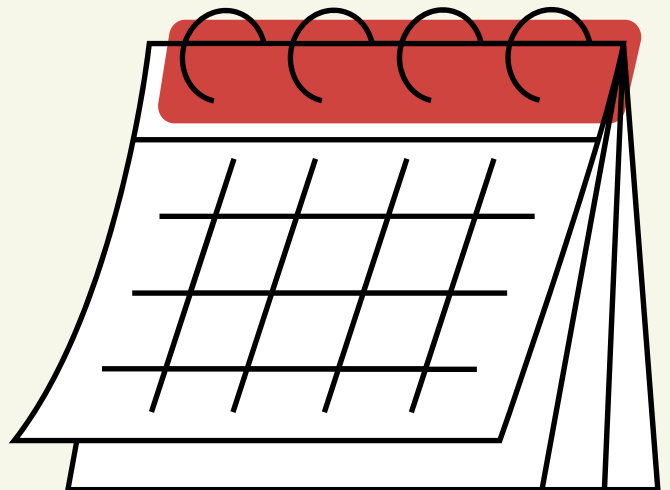

Youth Opportunity Fund

The Youth Opportunities Fund is a program that offers grants anywhere from \$250 to \$2,000 to individual Key Clubs. The fund operates in two cycles, first on October 15th and again on March 1st. A club can receive up to one grant per Key Club year. This grant can be used to help with service projects. To apply, your club must:

- Have paid the previous year's dues
- Sent in their application before 11:59 pm E.T. on the date of the cycle's start
- Complete a community needs assessment
- Support activities within at least one Kiwanis Children's Fund cause area (Health, education, or youth leadership development)
- Spend the grant money within 12 months of its reception

Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF is a fundraising program for children. All fund raised will go to "Start Strong: Zambia," which build schools in Zambia while also providing educational materials to the youth.
