Each club is eligible for one of these grants per year and can be offered anywhere from \$250 to \$2,000 to help fill one of your community needs. 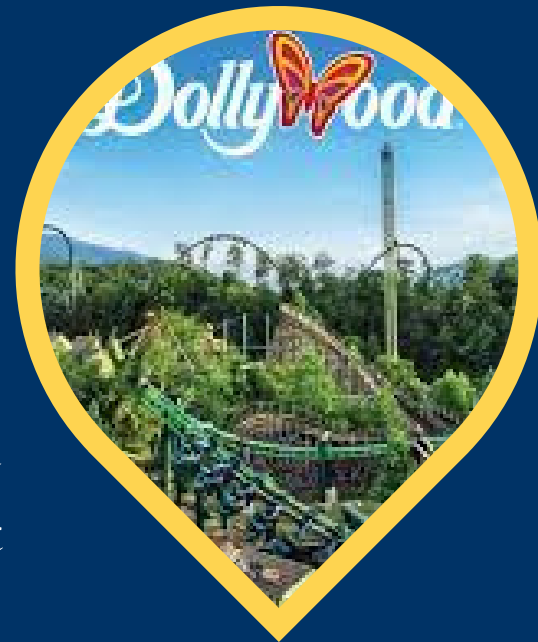
# Club Contacts

# The Ronald McDonald House Charity

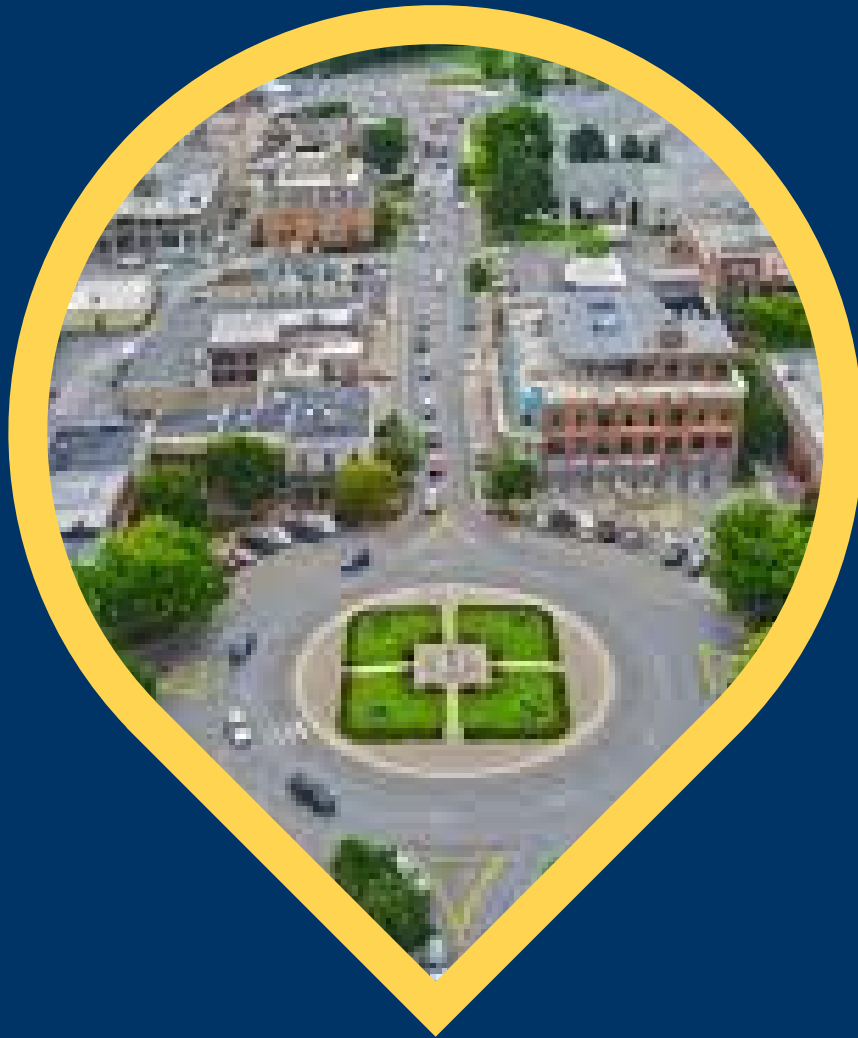
