Each club is eligible for one of these grants per year and can be offered anywhere from \$250 to \$2,000 to help fill one of your community needs. Applications are reviewed by the Key Club International Board in November. All grant recipients will be alerted within the first week of January. The Ronald McDonald House Charity

The Ronald McDonald House Charity (RMHC) has been operating for nearly 50 years thanks to the effort of its volunteers. If you didn't know, Ronald McDonald Houses are located near hospitals for the families of sick or injured children. They offer families a place to sleep, eat, and relax near the hospital they need access to. This offers comfort and normalcy to families who have to travel for healthcare. However as the RMHC expands in its mission to help, its volunteers are stretched thin. More volunteers are always wanted for something, and there's no such thing as too much help! Please consider scheduling a work day at a nearby RMHC location. Even something basic like helping make meals or creating getwell cards is appreciated. Remember not to show up unannounced, schedule a work day with the house manager ahead of time.
