Running for Lieutenant Governor

The Lieutenant Governor (LTG) is the chief executive of the division. They must keep their clubs informed and hold division meetings and projects. The LTG should attend District Convention 2023.

At the Division 10 Spring Rally (date TBD), LTG candidates will give speeches (approximately 3 minutes) about themselves, why they want to be LTG, why they should be elected, and what they would do while in office. They will also need to be prepared to answer questions. Candidates must be present at Spring Rally to run. They are required to attend 4 board meetings throughout the year: Spring

Board Meeting (April 12-14 in Knoxville, TN), Summer Board Meeting (June 21-23 in Knoxville, TN), Winter Board (November 15-17 in Lexington, KY), Convention Board (March 13), and District Convention (March 14-16, 2025). Running for District Office

District Governor

The governor is the chief executive officer of the district. They preside at all district board meetings and oversee the functioning of the district board and committees. They are tasked with overseeing a program to help all clubs in the district have a successful year. The duties of governor include:

2. Attend the Governor/Administrator Training Conference (May 2-5, 2024, Indianapolis, IN)
3. Attend and Preside at the Summer Board Meeting (June 21-23, 2024, Knoxville, TN)
4. Attend the International Convention (July 9-14, 2024, Atlanta, GA)
5. Attend the International Leadership Conference
6. Attend the Kiwanis District Convention (August 9-11, 2024, Gatlinburg, TN)
7. Oversee the planning, organization, and running of Dollywood Fall Rally (October 2024)
8. Attend and Preside at the Winter Board Meeting (November 15-17, 2024, Lexington, KY)
9. Attend the Kiwanis Mid-Year Conference
10. Preside at the District Convention (March 13-16, 2025, Lexington, KY)
11. Produce and Distribute newsletters to club presidents and to the board throughout the year.



District Secretary

The secretary takes and distributes minutes of all district board meetings. They are also responsible for district correspondence and reports and produce a district directory.

The duties of secretary include:

1. Attend Spring Board Meeting (April 12-14, 2024, Knoxville, TN)
2. Attend Summer Board Meeting (June 21-23, 2024, Knoxville, TN)
3. If possible, International Convention
4. If possible, Dollywood Fall Rally
5. Attend Winter Board Meeting (November 15-17, 2024, Lexington, KY)
6. Attend District Convention (March 13-16, 2025, Lexington, KY)
7. Produce and distribute newsletters to club secretaries and the board throughout the year.

District Treasurer

The treasurer is responsible for the collection of district dues and disbursing district funds properly. The duties of treasurer include:

2. Attend Summer Board Meeting (June 21-23, 2024, Knoxville, TN)
3. If possible, International Convention
4. If possible, Dollywood Fall Rally
5. Attend Winter Board Meeting (November 15-17, 2024, Lexington, KY)
6. Attend District Convention (March 13-16, 2025, Lexington, KY)
7. Produce and distribute newsletters to club treasurers and the board throughout the year.
8. Maintain accurate records of board members expense accounts and distribute expense checks in a timely manner.
