District Convention (DCON)

You must attend DCON if you would like to run for District Governor, Treasurer, or Secretary. We will have a keynote speaker (Josh Hiscock), service session, workshops, and more. Clubs will have the opportunity to enjoy free time in the Franklin/Nashville area! The theme is Sweet, Sweet Service. Registration (online and mailed) must be received by February 24. If your club has not received a DCON packet in the mail, please let me know!

International Convention (ICON)

International Convention 2024 will be July 10-14 in Atlanta, GA. Be on the lookout for Kentucky-Tennessee District Tour dates. At ICON, you can meet people from all over the world and learn more ways to serve your community!

Running for Office

District Governor

The governor is the chief executive officer of the district. They preside at all district board meetings and oversee the functioning of the district board and committees. They are tasked with overseeing a program to help all clubs in the district have a successful year. Produce and Distribute newsletters to club presidents and to the board throughout the year.

District Secretary

The secretary takes and distributes minutes of all district board meetings. They are also responsible for district correspondence and reports and produce a district directory. Produce and distribute newsletters to club secretaries and the board throughout the year.

District Treasurer

The treasurer is responsible for the collection of district dues and disbursing district funds properly. Produce and distribute newsletters to club treasurers and the board throughout the year. Maintain accurate records of board members expense accounts and distribute expense checks in a timely manner.

Lieutenant Governor

The Lieutenant Governor (LTG) is the chief executive of the division. They must keep their clubs informed and hold division meetings and projects. The LTG should attend District Convention 2023. At the Division 10 Spring Rally (March 9), LTG candidates will give speeches (approximately 3 minutes) about themselves, why they want to be LTG, why they should be elected, and what they would do while in office. They will also need to be prepared to answer questions. Candidates must be present at Spring Rally to run. They are required to attend 4 board meetings throughout the year: Spring Board Meeting (April 12-14 in Knoxville, TN), Summer Board Meeting (June 21-23 in Knoxville, TN), Winter Board (November 15-17 in Lexington, KY), Convention Board (March 13), and District Convention (March 14-16, 2025).
