While each individual RMHC has a wishlist, here is a general one. You can find out your local RMHC's on their website, or stay tuned for incoming information from the District Project Committee!

- Toys (new and in original packaging)
  - Board games
  - Stuffed animals and dolls
  - Books for various reading levels
  - Puzzles
  - Video games (rated E)
  - Balls and outdoor games
- Food
  - Canned goods
  - Non-perishable food items
- Household Items
  - Paper products (facial tissue, toilet paper, paper towels)
  - Trash bags
  - Aluminum foil, plastic wrap and sandwich bags
  - Laundry detergent and fabric softener
  - Cleaning products (sponges, dishwashing liquid, dishwasher detergent)
- Personal Care Items
  - Deodorant
  - Dental floss
  - Toothpaste
  - Soap
  - Shampoo/conditioner
- Gift Cards/Miscellaneous
  - Long-distance phone cards
  - Gift cards for local grocery stores and gas stations
  - Greeting cards and postage stamps
