WHAT IS A LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR AND WHAT DO THEY DO?

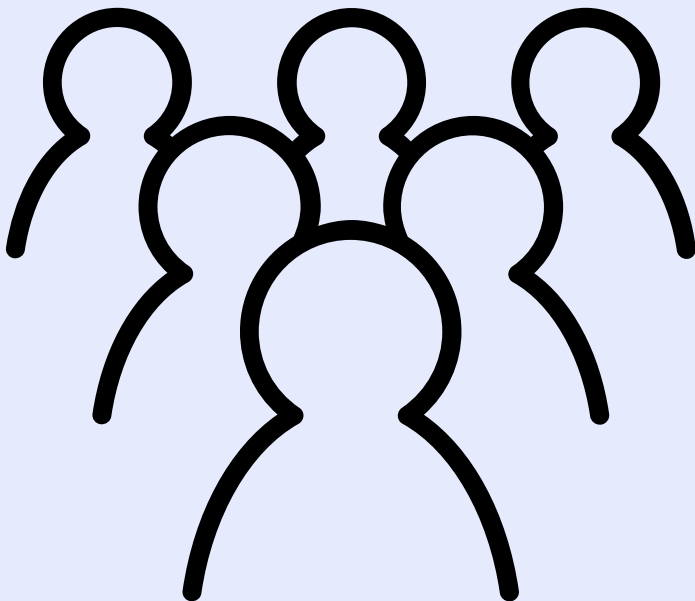
Lieutenant governors are apart of the district board and they manage their respective divisions. We go to 4 board meetings and plan events such as Fall Rally and DCON. You help the clubs in your division and plan division rallies such as officer training and spring rallies. When running, consider how much work it will be and decide if you will have time to attend all the meetings, zooms and other events you will have to attend as lieutenant governor.

HOW CAN YOU RUN FOR LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR?

You can run for lieutenant governor at spring rally. You will need to RSVP to me by email at katie@ktkey.org at least 10 days prior to spring rally (this would be January 13th). You will need to bring someone from your club to nominate you to run. Additionally, you will have 5 minutes to give a speech and answer questions asked by fellow key clubbers.

DO YOU HAVE AN OUTSTANDING MEMBER IN YOUR KEY CLUB?

If you have a member who goes above and beyond in your club and showcases the key club core values, spring rally is the time to nominate them for outstanding key clubber. This award requires a member to nominate another member. This member must be present to complete a short interview and then the outstanding key clubber will be decided by a nonbiased party. This is a low-key and stress-free interview, think of it more as a conversation to get to know you and who you are as a leader.
