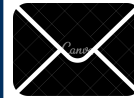

### All About me:

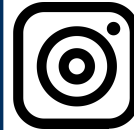

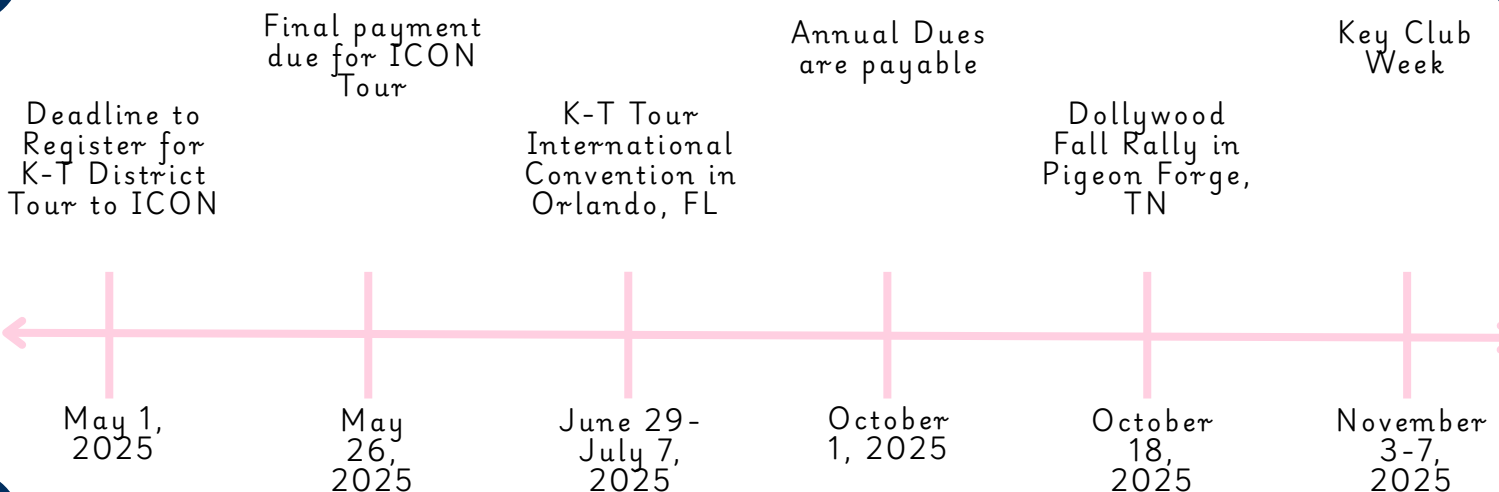
