The YOF is a grant that is given to only clubs specifically for a service project. To obtain the YOF grant, you must fill out a form about what the service project is that your club is interested in doing, it must be planned out precisely and detailed, afterwards proof of how you spend the money is required. You may request between \$250USD-\$2,000USD. There are two chances to get this grant, the applications for the first cycle must be received by October 15th at 11:59 p.m. ET. The applications for the second cycle must be received by March 1st at 11:59 p.m. ET.

RALLY

As usual fall rally will be located at Dollywood, in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee. At Fall rally we announce the theme of DCON, and members of key club are permitted to the full park after the sessions. Ticket prices for fall rally have yet to be announced but stay tuned on registration details. Parents are invited to attend fall rally as well! All attendees must fill out registration, including parents.
