CLUB DUES

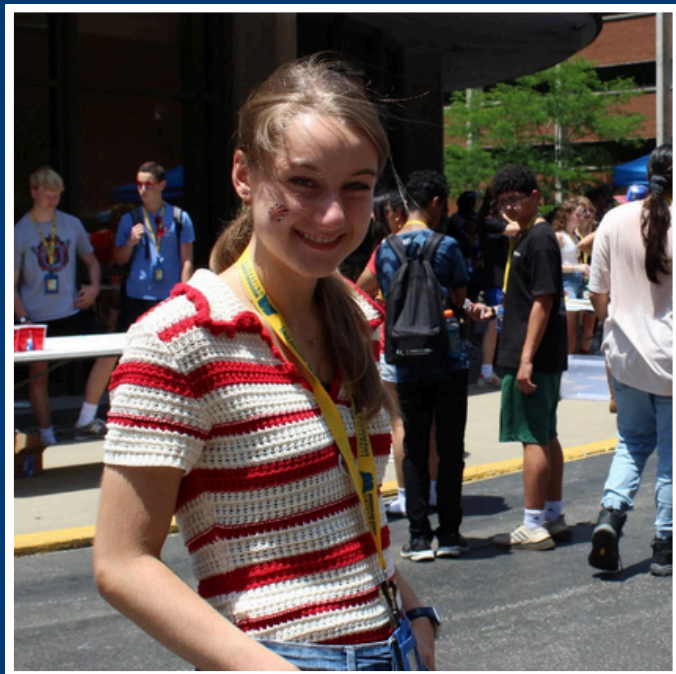
Club dues are payable October 1st and are due December 1st! Dues will be \$20 this year consisting of:

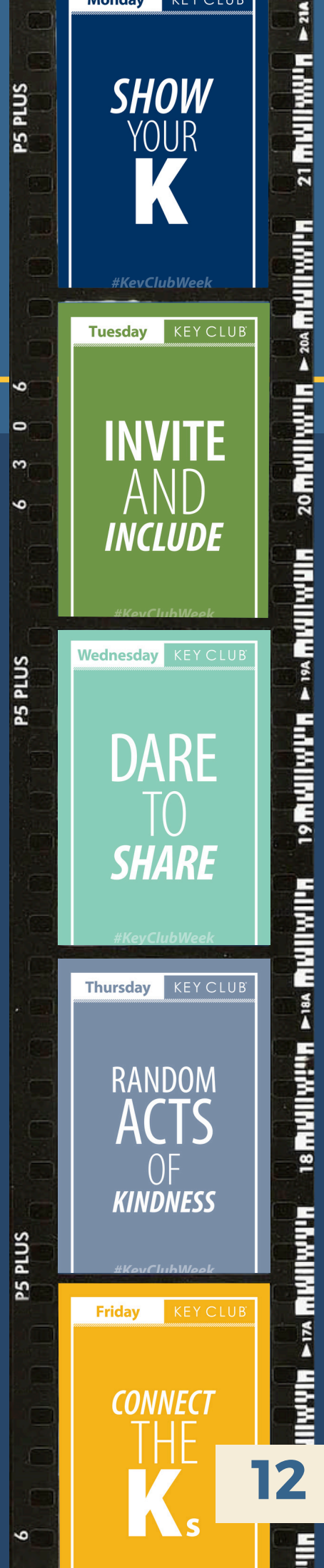

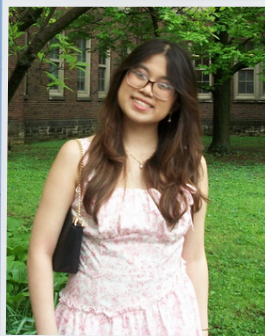

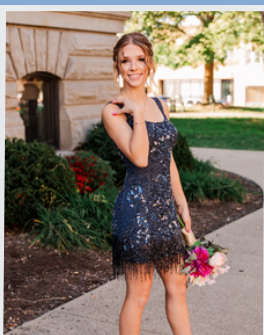
