The Youth Opportunities Fund, or YOF, is a grant that is designed to support service projects within communities. It can range from \$250-\$2,000 and is a great way to fund a service project for your club. The grant is only available to clubs, not divisions or districts, and there are 2 application cycles per year, October 15th, and March 1st. #### Dues

For those that don't know, Key Cllub annual dues become payable on October first. Dues are required from all Key Club members and are \$20, but if clubs get their dues in by November first, they get recognized at DCON and are presented with the Early Bird Award.
