# Treasurer Duties and Tips:

- prepare and distribute monthly financial reports and dues
- make sure your clubs pay their dues on time so your club does not become delinquent, suspended, or inactive
- delinquent clubs haven't paid by December 1st
- suspended clubs haven't paid by February 1st
- inactive clubs haven't paid by September 15th
- notify and help your advisor keep up-to-date with the expenses in your school account
- make sure you attend all your meetings
- stay on top of your duties and don't procrastinate
- learn how to count money
- most importantly, keep receipts and double check any expenses to make sure you have not added too much or not enough money
