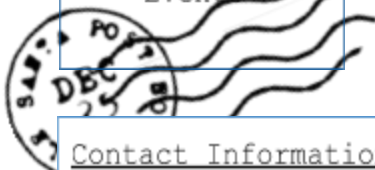


### Contact Information:
