Dues Payments:

Key Club International and our District dues are \$7 each and should be paid by October 1st of every year. To be an active club, dues must be paid by December 1st. If your club hasn't paid dues by December 1st, they become Delinquent. If clubs don't pay dues by February 1st, they become suspended. If the club still hasn't paid by next September 30th, the club will become inactive. Clubs do have a considerable amount of time to pay it but they're only \$14 so go ahead and get that out of the way. If they're paid by November 1st, your club will be presented an early-bird award at DCON!

YOF is trusted within Key CLub international and maintained by Kiwanis International Children's Fund. This fund is applicable to any club that wishes for a grant within the budget of \$100-\$2,000 for service opportunities.

Grants aren't applicable to division and district projects, they must go toward the club. The application must be submitted by October 15th; results of grant applicants would be revealed in January. The club's 2018-2019 dues must be paid before the YOF application is issued. So if your club has a BIG project planned, consider applying.
