Youth Opportunities Fund, or YOF for short, gives Key clubs the funds to greatly impact their community. Clubs may request funding assistance from \$100 to \$2,000. All YOF applications must be submitted by October 15th, those applications are reviewed by the Key Club board in November, and grants are given in early January. YOF grant money can be used in a variety of ways; DuPont Manual HS in Louisville, KY was granted 1,000 to create supply bags for Volunteers of America and Ridgeland HS in Rossville, GA used YOF grant money that helped provide a service dog to an individual in need.
