The YOF provides Key Clubs with the ability to preform service opportunities and scholarships.


## Info:

- Applications must be submitted online by October 15th at 11:59 pm, EST.
- Applications are reviewed by the Key Club board at the November meeting.
- Grant applicants are emailed the outcomes the first week of January.
- A list of grant recipients is posted online the third week of January.
- The club's dues must be paid before YOF grant checks can be issued.
- A YOF Grant Report is due at the end of the grant cycle (January 1st).
