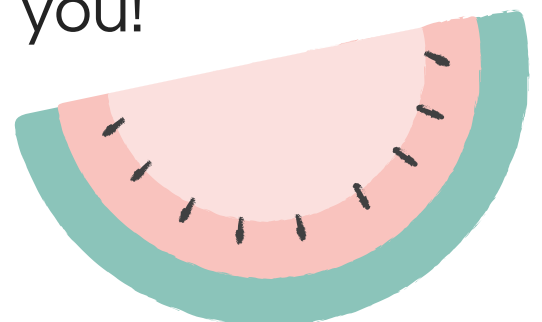

Youth Opportunity Fund (Basics)

The YOF is a way for clubs like yours to acquire the necessary funds for service projects. With these grants, your clubs can earn anywhere from \$100-\$2,000 in financial aid. If you're interested, turn in an application by 11:59 PM on October 15, and your dues must be paid before the grants are issued. A list of the recipients will be posted on the third week of January.
