

Youth Opportunities Fund



The Youth Opportunities fund (YOF) is a service that gives Key Clubbers the chance to earn scholarships and grants. YOF grants can be given to your club as a whole, or one member individually. Clubs may request funding assistance from \$100 to \$2,000. All YOF applications must be submitted by October 15th. Applications will be reviewed by the Key Club International Board in November, and grants will be given out in early January. The club's 2019-2020 dues must be paid before checks can be issued.

Trick -Or- Treat For UNICEF is a is a fundraiser sponsored by the U.S. Fund for UNICEF, in which Key Clubbers accept donations to help pay for shots that eradicate maternal and neonatal tetanus.
