The Youth Opportunity Fund is a service that gives Key Clubbers the chance to earn grants to complete service projects. These grants are intended to help clubs or individual members complete service projects that they may not be able to afford otherwise. YOF grants can be given to your club as a whole or to an individual member. Clubs may request assistance from \$100 to \$2,000. All YOF applications must be submitted by October 15th.



Applications will be reviewed in November and grants will be given out in early January. Your club's 2019-2020 dues must be paid before checks can be issued.
