Running for LT.Governor

The position of Lieutenant Governor is arguably the most important office in all of Key Club International beyond the club level. Serving as Lt. Governor is a great honor, responsibility, and opportunity for personal development. The Lt. Governor is the chief executive officer of the division. The Lt. Governor must keep all clubs informed about Key Club activities, events, and news. The Lt. Governor should also hold division meetings and projects so that clubs can get together and share ideas and work together in service.

At the divisional spring rally, candidates for Lt. Governor should be prepared to give a short speech (approximately 3 minutes in length) talking about themselves, why they want to be Lt. Governor, why they should be elected Lt. Governor, and what they want to do as Lt. Governor. Candidates should also be prepared to answer questions about themselves, their Key Club knowledge and activities, and their candidacy. You must be present at this rally to run for Lt. Governor!

RUNNING FOR DISTRICT OFFICE

You are eligible to run for the following District level positions: Governor, Secretary, Treasurer, and Lieutenant Governor. The District Governor, Secretary, and Treasurer position will campaign and be elected at District Convention.

The 2021-2020 Lieutenant Governor will be elected at my Spring Rally. You may also be endorsed for District Governor, Secretary, Treasurer, and International positions here as well.

Here is a brief description of these positions:

Governor

The governor is the chief executive officer of the district. The governor presides at all district Board meetings and oversees the overall functioning of the district board and district committees. The governor is charged with overseeing a program to help all clubs in the district have a successful year of service.

Secretary

The secretary takes and distributes minutes of all district board meetings. The secretary is also responsible for distributing District correspondence, District reports, and producing a District Directory.

Treasurer

The treasurer is responsible for the collection of district dues and for disbursing district funds at the direction of the board of directors.

Applications for District Historian and Bulletin Editor are available after District Convention.

Children's Miracle Network

What is CMN? It is a non-profit organization that raises funds for children's hospitals, medical research and community awareness of children health issues.

About them: Since 1983, Children's Miracle Network Hospitals has raised more than \$5 billion-most of it \$1 at a time-for 170 children's hospitals across the United States and Canada, which, in turn, use the money where it's needed the most.

These donations have gone to support research and training, purchase equipment, and pay for uncompensated care, all to save and improve the lives of as many children as possible.

- Assist families with children who require long-term care or who live great distances from hospitals.
