How to pay dues:

- 1. Go to www.keyclub.org
- 2. Look for the Dues and Reports Tab
- 3. Click on "Membership Update Center" (MUC)

4. When logging in for the first time, click "register/reset password" (The first time you use the system, do not fill in your email and attempt to put in a password. Instead, click Register/Reset Password the first time you use the MUC)

- 5. Once you have logged on:
 - Follow prompts on screen to Update advisor information, update officer information, update member information, and add new members
 - Generate an invoice by clicking "roster".
 - Print the invoice
 - Make payment according to the directions on the website
 - Follow the same steps each time you add members

*Remember that if you want to get the Early Bird Award, you must pay dues by December 1st! There is still time, so try and get dues turned in as soon as possible!

District Convention

DCON will be held from March 18-20, 2022 at the Marriott -Cool Springs Hotel in Franklin, Tennessee. The 2022-2023 District officers will be elected at DCON, and there will be a service fair, workshops, a dance, and more! The Keynote speaker will be Judson Laipply. Price will include 2 nights of a hotel room, 2 meals, all convention activities/programs, and convention souvenirs. The theme has been announced to be Saving the Superheroes of Service!

Running for Lt. Governor and District Office

If you are interested in becoming a Lieutenant Governor, you can run at Spring Rally, which is an event that will typically be held sometime in February. In order to run, you'll have to prepare a speech and go through a short questioning session. Then, the clubs in your division will vote to elect the Lieutenant Governor. This is a great opportunity to lead your clubs, so I highly encourage some of you to run for this position. If you are interested in holding an executive officer position, to include the District Governor, Secretary, or Treasurer, you will run at District Convention, also known as DCON. If you want to run for these positions, you will need to prepare two caucusing speeches, each less than 2 minutes, as well as a speech at the House of Delegates, which has to be under 5 minutes for the governor and under 3 minutes for the Secretary and Treasurer. Additionally, there will be a longer caucusing question session, and in the end, there will be an election for the executive officers.
