How to pay:

1. Go to www.keyclub.org
2. Look for Dues and Reports tab
3. Click on "Membership Update Center"
4. If logging in for the first time click on "register/reset password"
5. Once you have logged on:
 - Update all information; advisor info, officer info, and membership info as well as new membership.
 - Click roster which will generate an invoice
 - Print the invoice
 - Make the payment according to the website
 - Follow each step when adding members

Lt Governor and Officer Positions

If you would like to run for the Lt Governor position you will run at spring rally, normally held in February. You will have to prepare a short speech about what you plan on doing for your clubs and how you are a qualified candidate. I highly recommend running because it is a great way to meet new people and lead your clubs.

If you are interested in running for an executive officer position, District Governor, Secretary, Treasurer or Historian, you will run at DCON. You will need to prepare two caucusing speeches, each less than two minutes, as well as a speech at the House of Delegates, which will be under 5 minutes for the Governor and under 3 minutes for the secretary and treasurer. There will also be a longer caucusing question session which will be followed up with an election.
