Dues Payment

DUES THAT HAVE NOT BEEN PAID YET ARE NOW DELINQUENT. THE DEADLINE WAS JANUARY 1ST!

If your club hasn't paid dues yet, please get them ASAP, so your club can maintain its active status.

How to pay dues:

- 1. Go to www.keyclub.org
- 2. Look for the Dues and Reports Tab
- 3. Click on "Membership Update Center" (MUC)
- 4. When logging in for the first time, click "register/reset password" (The first time you use the system, do not fill in your email and attempt to put in a password. Instead, click Register/Reset Password the first time you use the MUC)
- 5. Once you have logged on:
- -Follow prompts on screen to Update advisor information, update officer information, update member information, and add new members
- -Generate an invoice by clicking "roster".
- -Print the invoice
- -Make payment according to the directions on the website
- -Follow the same steps each time you add members

Running for Lieutenant Governor and District Office

I will be holding my Spring Rally for Division 15 on Saturday, February 19th, 2022 from 1 - 3 PM at 331 Union St. Suite E2. At Spring Rally, we will be electing the new Lieutenant Governor (LTG) for Division 15, who will take my place for the next year.

To run for LTG:

- 1. Write a Declaration of Intent to me (include name, school, grade, and what position you are running for), the current LTG If you want to know about what the LTG does, here is a file that goes through what responsibilities the LTG has: https://drive.google.com/file/d/1v1sSDP03EsgkcJ1jOTLFLNyty2WA7HJu/view
- 2. Prepare a speech to give at Spring Rally (3 minutes)
- 3. Prepare for a questioning session that will take place at Spring Rally (to view sample questions, please click this link:
- https://drive.google.com/file/d/1vXipLDqVzYGiitxXEIxHWcZgKwM10GzN/view) Clubs are to send 2 delegates to vote for the new LTG. Each school's Key Club can have up to 2 delegates.

YOU MUST BE PRESENT AT SPRING RALLY TO RUN FOR LTG!

If you are interested in running for District Office, meaning District Governor, Secretary, or Treasurer, which are the 3 executive officers of the District Board for Kentucky-Tennessee, you can run for endorsement at Spring Rally. These positions are also open to all, but to run, you must attend DCON, which information about can be found at ktkey.org.

To run for these positions, please view these documents for a description of the responsibilities of each position, and what you will need to do in order to run. https://drive.google.com/file/d/1vECl29OVENKrwYWwIxjThduKtxcME0OX/view and https://drive.google.com/file/d/1weeS1phX6vyL41eKPR8MBkZMVeKxFqvn/view In addition to giving speeches at DCON, you will also have to go through questioning sessions, and for these, you can also look at the sample questions provided by the link above to prepare.

If you want to receive endorsement from our division for running for these positions, you must attend Spring Rally, where like the LTG candidates, please write me a declaration of intent, and prepare a 2-3 minute speech. You will also have to answer questions (The caucusing procedure is described in this document: https://drive.google.com/file/d/1vLT7qCNS90Q3VDyh1qvXCSZIRhVf2N6q/view). One

candidate can be endorsed for each executive position. You don't have to be endorsed to run for District Office, but if you are, it will help you when you run at DCON.
