DCON will be held from March 18-20, 2022 at the Marriott - Cool Springs Hotel in Franklin, Tennessee. The 2022-2023 District officers will be elected at DCON, and there will be a service fair, workshops, a dance, and more! The Keynote speaker will be Judson Laipply. The price will include 2 nights of a hotel room, 2 meals, all convention activities/programs, and convention souvenirs. The theme has been announced to be Saving the Superheroes of Service!

Registration is open now! The deadline for registration will be Friday, February 11th, 2022, so I encourage all clubs to start registering early. ICON- Key club's International Convention will be held in Washington DC from July 6th- July 10th, 2022. It is the biggest event of Key Club International where there are a lot of opportunities such as running for International Office, meeting your peers from all over the united states, listening to amazing speakers, electing new year's International Board and many more.

Spring Rally

Between the end of January and early March 2022, each current Lt. governor will hold a division rally to elect the 2022-2023 Lt. governor for each division.

Lt. Governor is arguably the most important office in all of Key Club International beyond the club level. Serving as Lt. governor is a great responsibility and a great opportunity for personal development

The Lt. Governor is the chief executive officer of the division. The Lt. Governor must keep all clubs informed about Key Club activities, events, and news. The Lt. Governor should also hold division meetings and projects so that clubs can get together and share ideas and work together in service.

The Lt. Governor should attend the District Convention in Franklin, TN, March 18-20, 2022. This is where Lt Governors receive training and are installed.

It is helpful if the Lt. Governor can attend the 2022 International Convention July 6-10, 2022, in Washington DC. Lt. Governors also plan and take part in the Dollywood Theme park Rally in October of 2022, and Division Rallies in the Spring, of 2023.

Lt. Governors in the K-T District have an expense account, so they can do their jobs without a personal financial burden. The expenses of attending board meetings are covered by the district and Lt. Governors receive an allowance to help offset the expenses of the International Convention. The district also helps provide transportation to all required meetings (listed above).

At the division rally candidates for Lt. Governor should be prepared to give a short speech (approximately 3 minutes in length) in the Spring rally telling about themselves, why they want to be Lt. Governor, why they should be elected Lt. governor, and what they want to do as Lt. Governor. Candidates should also be prepared to answer questions about themselves, their Key Club knowledge and activities, and their candidacy. **The SPRING RALLY DATE IS FEBRUARY 26, 2022 AT WARREN COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY.
