Calling all Clarksville-based Key Clubbers! Hilldale Kiwanis is offering a \$1000 scholarship, open to any and all seniors who are members of Key Club. This is a great opportunity that senior members should take advantage of. More information will be released soon, so keep an eye out for updates.

DUES PAYMENT

This year, dues are \$14 per person, with \$7 for local fees and \$7 for international fees. The Membership Update Center, where you will create a club roster and pay your dues, opened October 1. All clubs must pay dues to remain in good standing. Unpaid clubs will enter delinquent status December 1, suspended status February 1, and will lose their charter the following year if dues continue to go unpaid. Clubs that pay dues by November 1 are eligible for the Early-Bird Award at DCON.

Tuesday-- "Kudos to the Key Players" by thanking advisors

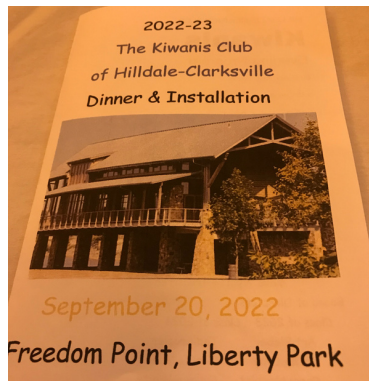
Wednesday- "Dare to Share" by celebrating diversity
