## DCON t-shirt Contest

- Must go compliment shirt color which is black.

## Spring Rally



- Spring Rally is an event within each division where the election of a lieutenant governor, district office, and the election of most outstanding key clubber takes place.
- If you are running for LTG you are going to have to prepare a short 2 minute speech and you are going to have a short questioning.
- Most outstanding key clubber nominees will be interviewed by a group of key clubbers.
- Each club showing up must have 2 voting delegates.
- This will most likely be held on March 4th, clear the date!

# Running for Lieutenant Governor (LTC) and District Office



Are you interested in becoming Division 6 Lieutenant Governor? If so, please let me know!

To run for LTC, you must give a speech at Division Six's Spring Rally. This will most likely be held on March 4th at Middlesboro High School. More information will be out soon. After your speech, delegates will take a vote and the new LTC will be announced!

To participate, your club must have paid dues for you to run for the position, two delegates from your club attending, as well as those running for Lieutenant Governor, are needed to attend Spring Rally in order to cast votes.



When it comes to running for a district officer position, things are a little different. It is recommended that you seek endorsement. You will also need to give a short speech on why you deserve an endorsement.
